Girl Scout Membership: Available to girls. Available to adult volunteers who are required to be members in order to fulfill their volunteer position. Pays for 1 year of membership (Oct 1 - Sept 30) in Girl Scouts of the Green and White Mountains. Participation in either, Fall Product or Cookie Sale, is required. Financial assistance cannot provide reimbursements if the membership is already paid.

Supply Voucher: Supplies can be mailed or picked up in Bedford or Williston.

Vouchers are available to girl members of GSGWM. A girl's Supply Voucher is good for the purchase of \$50 worth of the following eligible items:

- Girl Scout sash, vest or tunic
- Troop numbers (up to five)
- Flag patch
- Council ID set
- Membership pin
- World Association pin
- Girl's Guide to Girl Scouting
- Girl Scout Journey Book

Vouchers are available to eligible adult volunteers of GSGWM. An adult's Supply Voucher can be used for the purchase of his/her Pin Tab, Official Membership Pin and World Association Pin.

Sales tax and shipping (if required) will need to be paid as part of the \$50 voucher. Financial assistance cannot provide reimbursements if the supplies are already paid for.

Troop Dues: Available to girl members of a GSGWM troop, upon Troop Leader request. Amount granted (up to \$40) will be sent directly to the troop bank account and leader will be notified. To request Troop Dues leader should contact Customer Care.

Program, or Workshop Grants: Available to girl members of GSGWM for all programs listed in the Program Guide. Available to adult volunteers who are members of GSGWM and required to attend based on their volunteer positions (Outdoor Learning, First Aid, etc.) or are required to attend to maintain girl/adult safety ratios. If a required adult

workshop is not offered by GSGWM, financial assistance can be used to pay the fee of an event offered in the community (for example, a First Aid class offered by a hospital). Eligible programs or workshops include those offered by the council or community. Programs offered by GSGWM Partners are also eligible if they are included on the GSGWM online calendar of events. Financial assistance cannot provide reimbursements if the event is already paid.

Travel Grants (GSUSA Destination Trip):

Available to girl members of GSGWM. Financial assistance will only be available in the year that the trip occurs. Must be accepted by destination trip before applying for financial assistance. Submit a copy of acceptance letter with financial assistance request. Participation in both Council product sales programs required.

Travel Grants (GSGWM Travel

Opportunity): Available to girl members of GSGWM. Financial assistance will only be available in the year that the trip occurs. Must be registered for the trip before applying for financial assistance. Trip registrar will be notified of any assistance granted. Participation in both Council product sales programs required.
